PROGRAM 1: HSPT ACADEMICS

*The HSPT is the test used to determine Entrance & Scholarships
--including the Neumann Scholarship--to most area high schools.*

This academic program covers all areas of the HSPT: Math, Reading, Grammar & Cognitive. Dr. Pace includes her unique Strategic Approach, an Academic Review of All HSPT Subject Areas, Practice Tests, a Progress Report, Homework, Tutorials, and a Parent Meeting.

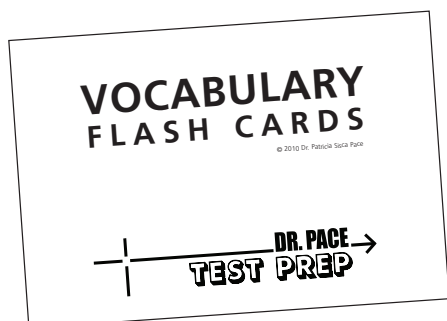

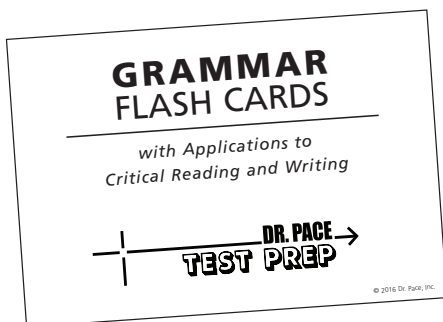

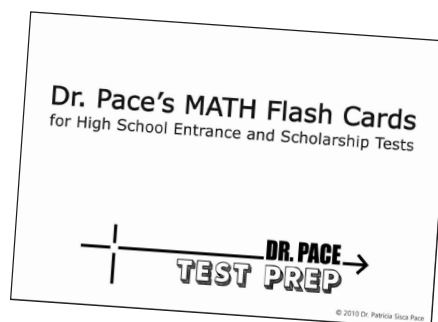
