

I would first like to thank you for all that you have done for me. My success is in no small part your doing and a credit to you and your courses.

I will be attending Carnegie Mellon University in the college of engineering (also called CIT - Carnegie Institute of Technology) with an intended major of Electrical and Computer Engineering (ECE). I was also accepted to UPenn, Pitt, and a few others. I was stuck between CMU and Penn for about three weeks (making my decision on April 28th) but ultimately concluded that CMU was better for tech.

I took the old SAT 4 times and did not take the new one. My first score was 1900. It increased to 2240 (superscore), my highest individual being 2170. My scores were R:730 M:780 W:730. I graduated from the Prep with a GPA of 3.774.

As I'm sure you can tell, I'm very excited for college. I am so very grateful for your help in getting me there. I'll be taking 4 courses my first semester: Intro to ECE, Fundamentals of Programming and CS, Calc 3, and a GER writing class with a focus in Sci-fi.
