



I recently attended Dr. Pace's art retreat, based on her book Coloring Without Lines: Art of the New Covenant. As a parent of several of her former students, I knew Dr. Pace to be an effective teacher and was intriqued by the idea of the retreat. The retreat experience was completely engaging. The structure of the workshop and Dr. Pace's clear step-by-step directions provided a safe space for exploring the connections to one's spiritual life. The entire process – listening, meditating on questions, writing, and using art materials, all in a supportive, peaceful setting – was as meaningful as the piece of art created.

Throughout the retreat, I felt there was room for me, as there was for all present, due to Dr. Pace's gentle encouragement and acceptance during the process.

4 HIGH SCHOOL ENTRANCE & SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS

(The HSPT Is the test used to determine Entrance & Scholarships--including the Neumann Scholarship--to most area high schools)

Program 1: HSPT ACADEMICS

3 Sundays, September 8, 15, 22, from 10:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. **COST:** \$135

Program 2: HSPT ACADEMICS

2 Sundays, October 6 and 13, from 10:00 a.m. to 1:45 p.m. **COST:** \$135

Both of the above Academic programs cover all areas of the HSPT: Math, Reading, Grammar & Cognitive. Dr. Pace includes her unique strategies, a review of all test subject areas, practice tests, a daily Progress Report, homework, and a parent meeting.

Program 3: HSPT BASICS
