The projected income from administration of Dr. Pace's programs in Spiritual-Academics is approximately \$100 per hour for a class size of 12.

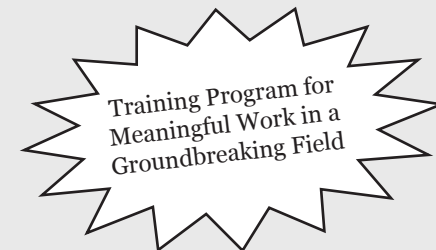
ABOUT DR. PACE

PART 1

Part 1 is therefore open not only to people who are interested in exploring the possibility of directing Dr. Pace's spiritual-academic programs but also to those who simply want to deepen their experience of Christian/Catholic spirituality, without necessarily going forward in the certification program.

PART 3

Course Topic: Spiritual-Academic Test-Prep Program for Elementary School Students

Fee: \$250 + class material

Session Dates for 5-Day Program:

PART 4

Trains Certification Candidates to Administer the *SAT Retreat*

Course Topic: Spiritual-Academic Test-Prep Program for High School Students

Requirements:

To proceed to Part 4, candidates must demonstrate mastery of *Slaying the Dragons of Standardized Tests*. In addition, participants must show that they have a student population to whom they can administer the *SAT Retreat*.

Fee: \$250 + class material

Session 1: 5 Hours

OBSERVE PROGRAM IN ACTION: Observe Dr. Pace administer the *SAT Retreat*.

Session 2: 4 Hours

Session 3: 5 Hours
