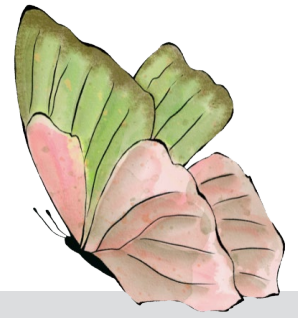

**SPRINGSIDE CHESTNUT HILL ACADEMY**

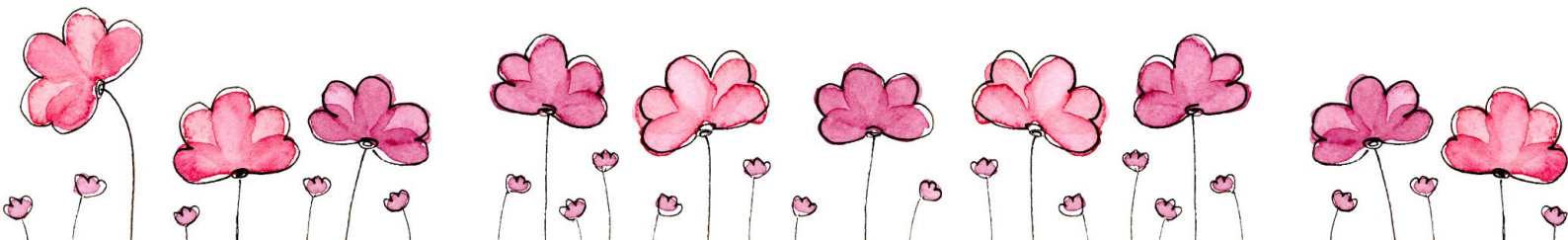
